An Introduction by the Author

Truly, we can find very few publications today where there is nothing about acupuncture and the wonders which it has aroused within the recent decade. All over the world there have been numerous seminars and conferences conducted; books, papers, and reports published on the subject. Those who live in Los Angeles have shown particular interest in this matter and are curious to know what this ancient science is all about.¹

It is unfortunate that one quite frequently hears some biased information about this science. We need to know the wide range of useful results this medical practice can do. I have decided to present this small collection of facts about the subject and I hope that this brief description will be an effective tool in introducing the practical benefits of acupuncture.

This is also an attempt to explain the magnetic treatment of diseases, a new chapter in the world of medicine, using simple day to day situations. This new field of medicine will undoubtedly become a very valuable bridge between the Western and Eastern medical practice. Magnet therapy, or energy therapy, will be the future of diagnosis and treatment in the world of medicine.

People all over the world are talking about acupuncture, which is a science with a history spanning two thousand years. But it did not draw the Europeans' attention until about three centuries ago when the French physicians started practicing acupuncture. Since then this particular method of treatment has found high acceptance in countries like Austria, Finland, Norway, Switzerland, England and America, recently in the last decade.²

The International Sanitation Organization in 1981 formally announced that at least 43 different kinds of diseases can be treated by acupuncture. This organization organized a seminar in Peking in 1979, and invited all physicians practicing acupuncture to come and discuss all ailments which can be treated by this method with other colleagues. It was at the end of this seminar that a list of diseases that can be treated by acupuncture was published and made available in the special publication of the International Sanitation Organization for the general public.

Unfortunately, the review of acupuncture and its vast domain cannot be completely covered in a publication of this length. For the same reason, perhaps the name "acupuncture" for this new-old science of medicine does not seem to be quite sufficient and explanatory. Many think that acupuncture is merely used to treat or to soothe the pain of the disease, but as was explained before, on the basis of the affirmation of the International Sanitation Organization, at least 43 ailments can be fully cured by this method. Oriental medicine, or acupuncture, with its ability to relieve pain and treat disease, should not be treated as an "unwanted" guest because of lack of knowledge about it, but rather should be considered an esteemed and honored colleague when discussing medicine.

In the medical world, acupuncture is called the medicine of the East. This is because the native home of this medical treatment is in China. Yet, throughout the centuries, the Japanese, Koreans and many other nations in the East have added concepts and practices to its evolution, and it is well justified to call acupuncture as "Oriental Medicine".

Another important consideration is the fact that acupuncture consists not only of puncturing the body with needles, but also includes prescription of beneficial herbs. These herbs, with more than 700 varieties, are so effective that Western pharmaceutical manufacturers have duplicated the formula of these herbal prescriptions, and to better sell the resulting products pharmaceutical companies claim that they have used the traditional formula of Chinese medicine.

A brief review of the history of acupuncture is necessary to know its evolution, and how it penetrated the Western world.

The Introduction of Oriental Medicine to the Western World

With the extension of Christianity into the Orient, the Christian clergies bowed to the wonderful remedial effects of acupuncture, and thus took very useful and extensive information back to the West as their souvenirs.

The first book about Oriental medicine was published by a man named Harvier in Europe in 1571. More than a hundred years later, in 1683, a distinguished surgeon of the Netherlands by the name of Ten Rhyne, published another book on the subject in English. But, as mentioned earlier, the French showed the earliest interest in acupuncture and the first French physician who began to treat his patients with acupuncture was Dr. Berlioz, who was quite famous in the field of music as well.

Soulier de Moran published an interesting book about acupuncture, which was 2,000 pages long. Soulier de Moran, the famous French Orientalist spent about 25 years of his life writing this extensive book in Shanghai, China. De Moran, who was not a physician, but an explorer of the world, was passing through China and noticed that there was an epidemic of blight, and that the Western medicines were of no avail. He observed with surprise that the Chinese physicians treated and cured the patients quite rapidly.

This curious Orientalist then returned to his country and in one of the most important medical centers he put forth his investigations and observations. This information was so highly attractive that all the professors engaged in that important research center not only approved of what he told them, but also requested that whatever he had learned in China be taught to the French physicians. Soulier de Moran did as he was asked, and at present there are more than three thousand physicians in France who are engaged in acupuncture and herbal medicine. Furthermore, the Institute of Acupuncture in France, which is affiliated with the International Society of Acupuncture, is presently one of the important centers of scientific and medical activities all over Europe. This is the same center which publishes a daily paper on the latest investigations of acupuncture, and holds seminars all over the world.

Acupuncture has been so extensively accepted in Europe that it is being taught as an academic course of study in medical schools there. It must be mentioned that this course of study in medicine is included in the studies for all specialized fields of medicine there, such as pediatrics, gynecology, dermatology, internal medicine, anesthesiology, neurology, etc.

It is important to point out here that acupuncture in Iran has also been quite in vogue, and sages of great fame like Aviceana, Zakana Razi, and Abureyhan Birouni have all been quite familiar with this particular form of treatment.³

The Ancient Science:
The New Technique

The Ancient Science: The New Technique

The Chinese discovered the direction of the flow of certain energy within the body of man about 2000 years ago. They knew that this energy was moving in different channels, and that each of these channels of energy was connected to the internal organs such as the stomach, heart, intestines, kidneys, lungs, liver, etc. In fact, the energy is transferred to these organs via these channels. The route and the directions of these channels are quite different from those of the nerves and the blood vessels in the body. This energy flowing in the body is nothing more than magnetic energy and the Chinese made a marvelous discovery based on this fact. The Chinese, after the discovery of these channels, found out that within this network of energy there are certain points of greater sensitivity, and by the excitement of these points, one can either decrease or increase the flow of energy in one direction or the other. The Chinese physicians gradually discovered the therapeutic specifications of these points to treat various ailments as well.

Yet the old science, using new and improved techniques of the modern times, brought forth another instrument which detected the acupuncture points of the human body. Before the appearance of this instrument the skill of the physician was indeed responsible for finding the sensitive points in the energy channels mentioned. This instrument identifies the acupuncture points and then the physician can, by acupuncture, excite that particular point.

The new and modern techniques have also rendered another valuable tool to the profession of acupuncture. This new technology has the ability to photograph the channels of the flow of energy within a person's body. This photography is one of the marvels of the present era, and it is indeed a marvelous feat to photograph an image, which even though existent, is not visible to the eyes of man.

Dr. Pierre De Vernejoul, M.D., an eminent researcher in France who is the director of the Nuclear Medicine Ward at Necker Hospital in Paris, with the help of Dr. Jean Claude Darras, M.D., Doctor of Aerospace Medicine, also a medical doctor at Necker Hospital, were able to photograph the channels of energy in the body by the injection of a radioactive matter called technitium.

Until the advent of this imaging, Western medicine looked upon these unseen channels of energy with much suspicion and disbelief. The reason for this was quite clear. Westerners do not really care much for things which are not tangible. Ironically it was a physician from England by the name of Sir Thomas Lewis who wrote, "There is an independent channel of power quite different from those of the nerves or blood vessels." Also, a Russian scientist named Sirgeyev discovered that even after death there remains a certain energy around the body which can be measured too. But, as mentioned, the people of the West only came to believe this when atomic photography made it definitely tangible.⁵

Examples of similar technology offering the same phenomena would include electrocardiogram of the heart, which is a reflection of the magnetic forces of the heart on a piece of paper. An electroencephalogram is the recording of the energy of the brain. Since magnetic energy is in the heart and brain, why then can there not be the same energy within other organs of the body which flows in its special channels?

How does ailment occur?

With the discovery of this energy, it was clear that as long as this particular vital quantity of energy is in proper balance, the body would be healthy and in good order. But as soon as there is disequilibrium or imbalance of this energy, then an ailment would appear.

Contribution of Acupuncture

When this energy loses its equilibrium, getting it back to its natural balance is not quite as easy as using chemical medicines. The contribution made to this particular aspect of medicine by acupuncture is rather marvelous and miraculous because by using the methods of this particular therapy we can again put the body back to its proper equilibrium easily and in the most natural way. This is basically what the science of acupuncture is all about.

The disequilibrium of the energy in the human body has three kinds:

1. Chi-deficiency, which is a decrease in energy.
2. Chi-excess, which is an increase in energy, or
3. Chi-stagnation, which is a blockage of energy.

A coordinating factor in health

In Oriental medicine, one particular organ alone is never under consideration. But what is closely observed and checked are a number of organs which are functionally connected with the ailing organ, and thus the condition of the energy running through them and the amount needed by each is thoroughly checked, and the proper coordination provided. In Oriental medicine, in order to treat a certain finger all the other connected or dependent organs of that finger and the internal organs will also have to be thoroughly tested. A complete cure cannot be achieved by treatment of the point of ailment or pain alone; any treatment must be done thoroughly and holistically, whereby all related organs are checked and put under care.⁶

When a part of the body is in pain, then the other organs in the energy chain are also affected. In this method of therapy it is not the puncture of the needle which brings back the equilibrium of energy, but the way the needle is inserted. Thus, what makes the difference is the method of turning the needle in the acupuncture points of the body. For example, if the needle is rotated in the direction of the channel of energy, or turned in a clockwise direction, it will increase the amount of the energy. If it is inserted opposite the direction of the channel of energy,⁷ or turned counter clockwise, then it will weaken the energy and it will soothe the ailing organ.

A simple illustration

To make this matter clear it is essential to use an example. As pointed out, what matters is the direction of the turn of the needle. A physician may want to dilate the blood vessels to overcome high blood pressure, or to constrict them to overcome low blood pressure, or overcome a case of dysentery or constipation. Therefore, he will insert the needle at some point of the body. In this case it would not be the puncturing of the needle, but the direction of insertion and the direction of the rotation of the needle that would bring about the desired therapeutic effect desired.⁸

ILLUSTRATION

The channel of the lungs begins inside the lungs and after running through the outer anterior section of the arms and the forearms, ends at the tip of the thumb. Now, if the doctor moves his hand in the direction of the channel along which this energy is flowing, the lung, which is the original organ of energy, meaning the oxygen, is reinforced. Thus the doctor is not able to bring down the hand of the other person (because the other person also carries the same magnetic energy).

We must keep in mind that the doctor's hand also carries this magnetic energy. Also, if the doctor moves his hand in the other direction, opposite to the course of the energy, this move will weaken the lungs and the energy will consequently decrease, and thus the doctor can bring down the hand of the patient quite easily.

1. When the doctor moves his hand on the upper extremity of the patient, in the direction of the channel of energy, he increases the amount of energy.
2. When increasing the amount of the energy, the doctor cannot easily bring down the patient's hand.
3. To weaken the energy, the doctor moves his hand on the upper extremity of the patient opposite the direction of the channel of energy, then the doctor can easily bring down the patient's hand.

The magnet replaces the needle

Now, all roads end up in Rome. We are talking about the new techniques and improved methods. At present, one can use a magnet instead of a needle. We already know that magnets have two different poles, north and south. Each of these has different therapeutic effects on the body. If instead of puncturing with needles and manipulating them in different directions, we use the different poles of the magnet, we can reduce the fear of needles that some people have that makes them reluctant to use acupuncture.

The idea of using magnets instead of needles comes from the Japanese, who have been able to achieve remarkable results by making use of modern improved techniques.

Although it is not possible to explain the whole complex process of acupuncture here, we can simplify explanations by comparing the therapeutic effects of Oriental and Western medical practices.

Chinese vs. Western Medicine

Western medicine recommends the use of cortisone for ailments of the joints, skin, heart, allergies, asthma and etc. All patients who are in need of cortisone can be treated by acupuncture. By using acupuncture on specific points of the body one can bring about the excitement of the adrenal glands to produce an increase in amounts of cortisone in the blood for a period of 48 hours. When this occurs, ketosteroid 17, a metabolite which is a form of cortisone, can be detected in the urine. This eliminates the danger of using too much cortisone in the body and more importantly, the needed cortisone is produced naturally by the body itself.⁹

Western medicine prescribes epinephrine or norepinephrine to widen the passageways of the respiratory system or tighten the blood vessels. Oriental medicine treats the patient by acupuncture so that the adrenal glands supply the needed epinephrine to bring about the same results.

The increase of leukocytes in the blood, which is of prime importance in the immune system of the body especially in infections, can be achieved by acupuncture.

To decrease the platelets and the erythrocytes of the blood, Oriental medicine can be of vital importance. In several cases where an excess of platelets endangered the lives of patients, acupuncture was substituted for surgery and removal of the spleen, and it had quite remarkable results.

By acupuncture, it is possible to bring about the excitement of the adrenal glands and hormones such as DOCA or ACTH and testosterone can be produced in the body for specific therapeutic purposes.¹⁰

To cleanse the stomach and intestines or overcome laziness of the digestive system, one can use acupuncture quite successfully because it is possible to increase the peristalsis, or movements of the intestines, for digestion of food and elimination of food-waste. Additionally, it is possible to stimulate the stomach to produce more pepsin to treat chronic gastritis.

Acupuncture has definite, tested ways of treatment for balancing the secretions of the internal organs as well as the thyroid gland when the patient is ailed by endemic goiter. By this method it is even possible to decrease the size of the thyroid gland and get rid of its undesirable appearance; as well as decrease the amount of iodine in the urine, which can be an indication of the absorption of this substance by the thyroid gland.

These are only a few examples. The Chinese physicians themselves are inclined to believe that for many of the ailments for which Western medicine has been inefficient, Oriental medicine has been remarkably successful, and these would include psoriasis (a skin disease), lupus erythematosus (an ailment of the immune system of the body), asthma, high blood pressure, blood disease, diabetes, changes of ratios of the corpuscles in blood, and even AIDS and cancer.¹¹

An awareness of Western Medicine

There is no doubt that a practitioner of acupuncture needs to learn Western medicine too. A practitioner of Eastern medicine should not hesitate to investigate the fields of Western medicine. In fact, such a practitioner should, by all means, acquaint himself with the latest discoveries and developments within the disciplines of Western medicine as well, so he can recognize the differences between functional and organic diseases. He can therefore bring about normal functioning of the body that Western medicine achieves by chemical drugs, through acupuncture. This is the reason why medical school in China takes eight years, so that medical students can become knowledgeable in both Western and Oriental Medicine.

In this brief paper, discussion would only be about the natural energy of the body; the equilibrium and the proper balance of this inner energy, which can be affected with the use of the magnet.

A healthy body acquires the necessary energy from its environment. This energy is the magnetic energy of the earth, which indeed provides for the health and well-being of all living creatures. Any living creature, if deprived of this energy by natural or artificial means, will acquire various diseases, and finally die. Because of this discovery, many scientists throughout the world began doing research about magnetic forces, and have achieved remarkable results in this particular field of medicine. The surgery group at the University of Pennsylvania has even been able to attain miraculous results in treating broken bones by using magnets, without an open operation.

Who was the pioneer in Magnet Therapy?

Contrary to popular belief, it was not the Japanese who were the ones who first investigated the natural magnetic forces in the body. It was even thought that the discoverer of this natural force of vitality was Samuel Hahnmann, the father of homopathy who only found out about this phenomenon about 150 years ago. In truth, the discoverer of the natural magnet was the distinguished Iranian scientist, Avenzoar (the famous Persian physician Ali Abbas or Bu Ali Sina), who discovered it as early as 1000 A.D. In one British publication, there was an article about Avenzoar, which mentioned that he had been the original discoverer of the natural magnet, and that he used it in his practice of medicine about 1000 years ago, with full knowledge of the mysteries of its therapeutic effects. Avenzoar reportedly had treated his patients by magnets in cases of muscle spasms, ailments of muscles and orthopedic diseases, as well as for gout. He knew a thousand years ago that gout was the result of the collection of uric acid in the joints, so he used magnet therapy to get rid of it by increasing the flow of blood. There has also been some evidence that show that people in the 16th century were using the same method of treatment to speed up the flow of the blood to repel excess bilirubin in order to get rid of excess bilirubin in hepatitis patients.¹²

MAGNETS AND IRON IN THE BLOOD

Most of the diseases which are found in the body are caused by poor flow of blood through the systems or the particular organs. Headaches and dizziness results from discrepancy of blood flow within the brain system.

Heart problems are developed by blood flow problems through the muscles of the heart. Baldness, wrinkles on the face, pain in the back and shoulders, sleeplessness, lack of ability to concentrate, and many kinds of stress and diseases are all consequences of disorders of blood flow through particular organs in the body.¹³

An investigator at South Hampton University in England named Dr. Melwill has done some interesting research on this and has achieved valuable results. Dr. Melwill's investigation proved that the erythrocytes in blood are bound together by magnetic force. Therefore one can excite these corpuscles by using a magnet. Dr. Melwille explains, "The erythrocytes are bonded together by magnetic force, and the iron of the hemoglobin inside the erythrocytes can be put to motion by a magnetic force, as a result of which the blood can move and flow smoothly to treat some diseases."¹⁴

The Institute of Biomagnetics in New York, under the supervision of Dr. Kenneth S. MacLean, has achieved quite remarkable results in this regard. The researchers of this institute are of the opinion that if changes which occur in cancer cells are a result of disequilibrium of energy (magnetic), then if this energy is put back to its proper balance at the site of this cancer, the tissue affected will heal.

Another researcher, Dr. Burr believes, "The human body in itself is a biomagnetic system which is continuing its life in a magnetic environment. Therefore the living things on earth all possess this magnetic energy, the deprivation of which can cause disease and even death."¹⁵

THE EFFECTS OF THE NORTH AND SOUTH POLES

A group of Japanese researchers, together with the help of a group of French scientists, discovered that if one uses the South or North poles of a magnet on specific points of acupuncture, or on the new points which have been discovered by the Japanese, he can attain the same therapeutic effects which the Chinese achieved by acupuncture. The Japanese and the French came to the conclusion that, with magnotherapy, there is no need to use acupuncture, which may cause some discomfort.¹⁶

With magnotherapy, one can restore the natural balance of energy in the diseased organ, so that the body can regain its natural functioning. Magnotherapy presently is being used in most fields of medicine and has brought about a revolution in all branches including dentistry, in which the arrangement of teeth is altered by this same method.¹⁷

The use of magnets has become one of the most important scientific discoveries, not only in the field of medicine, but also in the field of agriculture. The Ministry of Agriculture in the U.S.S.R. has been using magnetic devices to increase the growth and production of agricultural products. In Canada farmers have also been using some similar devices on their farms.

The use of magnets in medicine requires abundant experience and specialized training because the positive and negative poles have different therapeutic effects, which are summarized in the following list:

The North or the Negative Pole:

1. This pole is quite effective in treating obesity by balancing the protein activities of the body, because it is a retarder of these sorts of activities.
2. It decreases the water of the body; therefore it has good effects on body contouring.
3. It causes contraction, and vasoconstrictive action causes the making of alkaline substances in the cells of the organs; therefore it is effective in sedation and relief of pain.
4. It is effective in decreasing the activities of cells.
5. It can increase the potassium in the blood.
6. It can cause a decrease in excess calcium ions, and can be very effective in treating arthritis and joint pain.
7. It can dissolve cholesterol on the wall of the blood vessels as well as decrease the fats of the cholesterol contained in the blood.
8. It can ~~reverse the conduction of the blood~~, so it can stop bleeding.
9. It can prevent the growth of viruses and microbes, therefore its effect is similar to that of antibiotics.¹⁹

The South or Positive Pole:

1. It can cause an increase of protein action in the cells and thus bring about weight gain.
2. It distributes the water in the body.
3. It can cause an expansion of the blood vessels, and with the increase of vasodilatation it can bring about an increase in acidity of the cells.
4. It can increase activity.
5. It can increase sodium in the blood.
6. It can increase the growth of microorganisms and viruses.
7. It can increase the erythrocytes of the blood.²⁰

Another opinion regarding the energy flow of magnets, as expressed by Dr. Ted J. Zablotzky, is as follows: "It is a historic error that the earth's geographic North Pole is not referred to as a magnetic South Pole. When the early compass needles were suspended, the tip of the needle which pointed towards the geographic North was labeled as the magnetic North Pole. The laws of physics eventually explained that only opposite magnetic poles attract, thus proving that a pole drawn to a magnetic South Pole should be considered a magnetic North Pole. Therefore, in reality, the geographic North Pole is a magnetic South Pole, and vice versa.

THE RELATIONSHIP OF MEDICINE AND THE MAGNET

Magnotherapy is an applied, preventive medical science. Checking the condition and level of wellness of the internal organs can be done by placing a small magnet on three separate pulses on each wrist. The left wrist has pulses for the heart, liver and kidney and urinary bladder, and the right wrist has pulses for the lungs, stomach and kidney. By placing a magnet on each pulse, one at a time, it is possible to diagnose the connection between the organs and glands by a simple muscle test.

With the magnet on the proper spot, the patient is told place the arm on a flat surface and hold the thumb and index finger together. If the patient is balanced in that area, the doctor will not be able to separate those fingers. If the patient has imbalance, the doctor will be able to separate those two fingers very easily. So, we can check the activity of the internal organs by a simple muscle test, and if found to be out of balance, can be put into a state of equilibrium in a matter of a few minutes. When this equilibrium is established, the patient encounters a soothing relaxation and feeling of abundance of energy. It is in this balanced state that the physician can attend to the diseased organ and perform a significant treatment. Thus, magnotherapy allows the physician to specify suitable treatment for that particular diseased organ.²¹

The Japanese believe that it is the body itself that must choose the suitable medicine for its own benefit, so with magnets and the help of a muscle test one can find out the most suitable treatment which would bring about complete health. This can only be achieved through the equilibrium of the magnetic energy of the body and through the proper knowledge of the most suitable medicine containing magnetic energy.²²

THE TEST BY THE U.S.S.R.

In 1959, the U.S.S.R. brought about a new chapter in diagnosis and in magnotherapy because the sending of the Sputnik satellite opened a new chapter in the science of biomagnetism.

It was during that same time when John F. Kennedy, the President of the United States ordered extensive research about magnetism and the translation of publications about space magnetism into English, as well as the collection of scientific facts on the subject. It was after these investigations that the first man set foot on the moon, because then the mystery of the relation of man with magnetism had been discovered. The scientists understood that man is but a biomagnetic being living in an electromagnetic atmosphere, because man is not able to separate himself from this electromagnetic atmosphere which surrounds him. The famous book "Biomagnet" is a memorial to the same period. Therefore, we have now come to know that any disequilibrium between the magnetic energy of the earth and that of man can cause disease and ailments.²³

THE SOURCE OF DISEASE IN THE CONTEMPORARY WORLD

Surely you have read or heard that man in this age of civilization is facing various different diseases which were not known before. You have also heard that villagers and those who live in the wilderness are much healthier and stronger than those who live in towns and cities, as well as having longer life spans. But you may not have thought of the reasons why man of the era before this great civilization, or the villagers of the present civilization have lived much better and healthier lives than the urbanites of the present time.²⁴ Take a look at the cities and you will see the high antennas, automobiles, the high buildings made of iron and steel. You can see how the energy of the earth is absorbed by those irons and the metals before it can reach the body of man. The truth is that urban man at this age has almost lost his connection to the magnetic energy of the earth, and this is indeed the main cause of his physical and mental afflictions.

Have you ever asked yourself why you feel so relaxed when you go for a nature trip into the forests, mountains, desert or countryside, far away from the cities? The farther you get from the centers of the civilization and the closer you get to the purities of nature the more healthy and comfortable you will feel. The answer is that you establish a closer and more direct relation with nature and its abundant energy, and thus you are able to receive the vital magnetic energy directly and in sufficient amounts.

Dr. Kyoichi Nakagawa, in the Japanese Medical Journal, has brought forth new information which has added a new syndrome to the science of medicine. Dr. Nakagawa speaks about magnetic field deficiency syndrome. The deficiency of the infiltration of the magnetism of the earth into the body of man causes symptoms such as backaches, shoulder pain, habitual constipation, sleeplessness, stress, chronic headaches, and heaviness of the head.²⁵

The Japanese and Americans have discovered that within the last five centuries, the earth has lost 50 percent of its magnetic energy and for each century it will lose another 5 percent of the same energy, each year 0.05 percent and there will come a day when magnetic energy of the earth reaches zero quantity, and that would be the day which the scientists called the end of life of the earth. They have estimated that this will happen approximately 2000 years from now.²⁶

MAGNOTHERAPY AND BEAUTY

Since there is much talk about getting rid of the wrinkles of the face by acupuncture, we will try to inform you about the current state of affairs in this particular field. The climatic conditions around Los Angeles makes its environment quite dry; therefore the faces of people who do not perspire naturally soon become wrinkled. The best method of getting the faces of such people to perspire without any artificial treatment is the use of magnotherapy. Magnotherapy also has special uses in health and in beautification. One could write a whole book on the subject of wrinkles alone, but in brief, every single wrinkle on the face is a sign of some sort of disequilibrium of energy within one of the internal organs of the body. In fact, it is quite safe to say that the face of a person can be considered to be a mirror of the condition of health of that particular individual.

For example, having wrinkles around the lips is a clear sign of laziness of the liver. Wrinkles of the forehead, if more than usual, are signs of some ailment in the digestive tract. Wrinkles between the eyebrows are signs of disease in the stomach, and swelling under the eyes, especially if the swelling is yellowish brown or blue color, is related to some disease of the stomach, liver, and the kidneys. Wrinkles around the eyes are a sign of some disease in the heart, in the lungs, or in the small intestines. Therefore, before one does anything about the wrinkles, he should first treat the particular organ of the body which has lost its equilibrium of the natural energy. It is quite natural that when that organ is put back to its state of well being and health, the wrinkles brought about by it will also disappear in a short time or they can be treated locally by massage or other methods. Otherwise, if the treatment is only done locally, though it may improve for a time, the wrinkles will reappear after some time. Even if one undergoes plastic surgery, the wrinkles may occur again, unless the ailing organ is also put back to its state of balance.

The Japanese in this particular field have achieved remarkable success and have found out that most of the wrinkles of the face are caused by an improper flow of blood which can be treated, as mentioned before, by increasing the speed of the flow of blood to the tissues of the face and thus get rid of the wrinkles.

The notable point here is the fact that with this method of treatment one can so rapidly improve the freshness and the beauty of the face that a lady would not be in need of any make-up. By magnotherapy, the face becomes quite good looking, the skin thoroughly brilliant, and the eyes tremendously attractive, glowing and bright. As we explained, most of the diseases of man are caused by a discrepancy in the proper flow of blood. Nervousness, stress, headache, chest pain, heart attack, cerebral apoplexy, bad temperament, bad memory, losing hair, muscular pains, diseases of the stomach and intestines, lack of energy, worry and wrinkles on the face can all be overcome by proper flow of blood.

THE BEGINNING OF TREATMENT

A considerable amount of magnetic energy is applied for a few times of treatment so that the lack of energy is overcome and compensated. At this time the patient is put back to a state of balance and thus he will regain his health and well being.

Recently, a Japanese firm has produced a set of magnetic mattresses, pillows, comforter and insoles which can be placed inside the shoes. If people use these types of products they can overcome their lack of magnetic energy. Afterwards they will not only be able to sleep comfortably, they will also wake up the next day with more energy.

Other Japanese factories have produced magnetic wrist bands, elbow bands, and knee bands, as well as bands for shoulders and waist, all of which are approved by the Ministry of Health and Welfare in Japan, so that a physician can prescribe them for a patient after providing their lack of energy by magnetic therapy.

Biomagnetic Diagnosis in Radiology

Magnetic Source Imaging (MSI)

Magnetic source imaging (MSI) detects changes in the minute magnetic fields associated with nerve activity. MSI plays a large role in the diagnosis and treatment of patients with functional diseases as CAT scans and MRIs now do in the management of patients with pathologies that disrupt normal structure. MSI's promise lies in its potential to noninvasively image diseases that cannot be visualized by anatomic imaging methods of CT and MRI. The use of MSI would facilitate diagnosis of structural lesions that leave little or no diagnostic mark on CT or MRI. There is a need for a technology that complements existing imaging modalities by giving functional information.

Meanwhile, the preliminary results of limited clinical studies performed on patients with such diverse maladies as epilepsy, stroke, migraine headache and cardiac arrhythmias have generated optimism among biomagnetism's advocates.

Most clinical applications envisioned by MSI experts involve delineating biomagnetic information in relation to anatomic structures as visualized by CT or MRI. With their anatomic imaging expertise and machines already in place, radiologists make logical candidates for membership in any MSI research group.

In contrast to the electrical signals of EEG and ECG, magnetic fields pass through tissues virtually undistorted. This property gives MSI its big advantage: relatively simple and straightforward modeling that allows the technique to precisely localize the source currents of nerve activity.

The technology behind MSI is by no means simple, however. Because the magnetic fields being measured are so small, the dominant engineering requirement has been to screen out noise in the forms of both magnetic and radiofrequency interference. To this end, the instruments are constructed of nonmagnetic materials and isolated within shielded rooms. Built with the same principles involved in containing the strong magnetic fields of MRI scanners, the shielded rooms represent about half the total cost of the systems.

MSI experts envision that most clinical applications will involve delineating biomagnetic information in relation to anatomic structures as visualized by CT or MRI. Superimposed MSI data on cross-sectional MR images of drug-resistant epileptic shows location of interictal spike activity.

I hope that this summary will bring you up to date on the subject of magnotherapy. If only one person can find the way to his or her cure and well being, I will have received my spiritual rewards and compensation forever.

Energy Therapy: The Future of Diagnosis and Treatment?

Orthodox medicine has always worked on the assumption that unless a condition can be diagnosed, it cannot be treated (regardless of symptoms) and those that do treat such cases are unorthodox or quacks. The problem is attempting to diagnose from body chemistry and not from the energy deficiency of organs.

Energy therapy will be the future form of treating disease. We know that any living thing deprived of the earth's relatively weak magnetic field for prolonged periods will suffer complex and distressing illness and will eventually die. All known mass extinction of earthly life, including dinosaurs occurred when the planet's magnetic field was reversed. When this happens, there are periods of zero magnetism which, if prolonged, can kill every living thing in the null geomagnetic area.²⁹

In one way or another, nearly every human ailment is caused or affected by electromagnetism. Some of the primary discoveries of the human biomagnetic fields were made when Dr. Robert O. Becker of New York Upstate Medical Center mapped it out during his researches in Syracuse. After a series of highly specialized experiments, the evidence compiled by Dr. Becker and his colleagues (Dr. Charles Bachman and Professor Howard Friedman) persistently implied that magnetism is, in fact, the very key to the secret of life. It is a nonphysical force that affects all living organisms.

Dr. Burr, a recent researcher, believes that all life in the universe is interconnected and influenced by energy force fields. He theorized that energy fields are actually prephysical fields which organize the physical body as it continuously undergoes the process of growth and metabolic change, the construction and destruction of cells.

Dr. Burr maintained that measurement and analysis of the energy fields had great potential for application in the medical field and that abnormalities in the energy field could give advance warning of future symptoms before they become evident. This is now being advanced using magnetic energies to measure organ function as well as shifts in the body's energy field.³⁰

Man, like all living creatures, is an electromagnetic system in an electromagnetic environment from which he cannot isolate himself. His health and body functions all depend on electromagnetic energy fields and these energy fields are now used to measure organ function. They can be used to determine the acid-base balance (PH) of each organ and the potential health of the patient.

Polar Therapy: Both a Science and an Art

Polar therapy started many years ago. The Greek physician, Galen in his ninth book mentions the use of magnetism in healing as early as 200 B.C. He describes his early research with magnetism as an outstanding "purgative".

The famous Persian physician, Ali Abbas, in about 1000 A.D. describes his findings in using magnetism to treat such disorders as "spasms" and "gout", in the 16th century A.D.

Paracelsus, physician and alchemist, wrote of his work in relieving conditions of "hernias, dropsy, and jaundice" with magnetic applications. In 1975, Russian scientists linked electromagnetic sunspots to flu epidemics. Dr. Melville, University of Southampton, England affirmed that red blood cells in human blood are attracted by magnetic fields. You can see that science has been around a long time, yet science could not explain what it was and why it worked. Magnetism kept dying a slow death only to be revived from time to time because of its beneficial effects in reversing degenerative disease and relieving pain.³¹

In the course of events, NASA published a book on "Biomagnetism". In Vol. 66, the opening statement reads "Biomagnetism is the study of electromagnetic fields in man which originate in the biological systems" which are all living systems - man, animal, vegetable and plant.³²

From this research, science found that man cannot exist outside of a magnetic field. Everything in nature, including man, depends on electromagnetic energy to exist. Man is nothing more than a biomagnetic energy field. Any interference in this energy field affects the health and activity of the individual.

The above-average thinking scientist and doctor today realize that within the next 10 years, the treatment of all men's ills and health problems will be dealt with and treated also biomagnetically and/or bioelectrically.

Today we are learning a lot about the electrical body. Man is a bioelectric field, right down to each individual cell. Each cell is a tiny battery, having a positive nucleus rotating clockwise (or a right spin) and the outside shell or protoplasm with a negative charge spinning counterclockwise (or a left spin). This produces a small current. Thus each cell becomes a tiny battery. Because the body is made up of trillions of cells, our body becomes an energy factory and if it is producing correct energy fields, disease cannot exist.³³

Disease cannot exist in a balanced energy field. The body must be in a disease-acceptable state for disease to manifest. The body must have the ideal conditions for the disease (or pathogens) to exist and affect the body in a negative manner.

Since a certain percentage of our population is disease-immune, we must realize the body can be in such energy through scars or grooves too. This battery is affected by the quality of food or fluids put into it. Poor food can short circuit the battery, causing a field of interference.

If cells receive a strong stimulus for a prolonged period of time, cell membranes can become permanently depolarized, thereby becoming unable to repolarize themselves. When this happens, the cells become continuously weaker and more susceptible to illness.

The onset of a cold is an example. Before one becomes aware of having a cold, that individual may feel weak and tired. The cells could have been weakened by temperature changes, stress, poor diet, or other negative stimuli. The cells lose energy. Then the weakened organ or tissues become alkaline, creating a fertile ground for virus.

When the virus invades, a person will experience chills, stuffed nose, and fever. The body requires rest and exposure to minimal stimuli so that it can recuperate from the viral infection. Again, I stress that all of this is the result of energy loss in cells.³⁴

Any organ that has been diseased will continue to block or withhold energy until the cells return to normal. These include scars, teeth, sinuses, tonsils, kidneys, liver, heart, lungs, thyroid, appendix, and more. Body organs receive energy from each other so if one organ is sick, energy is blocked. Even healthy organs become weakened when energy is not transmitted from diseased organs. Other illnesses are then likely to occur.

Illness develops in six stages. The first three stages are acute ones and include excretion, reaction, and deposit formation of accumulated toxins. These are the general and less serious illnesses such as colds. The body can usually cope by itself if no heavier stresses are introduced.

If the mind or body is severely traumatized by an accident, operation, or depression, the body moves into the chronic stages of illness which are: impregnation (higher level of toxin deposits), degeneration (serious disease), and neoplasma (cancer).

The function of energy replacement therapy is to reverse the illness cycle by starting the process of detoxification and energy replacement therapy. A mere glance at a bioenergy picture of a person can lead to a diagnosis of even the most complicated case. Bioenergy has matured to the point of detecting clinically-manifested diseases, with or without symptoms, which have developed over the years in a prodromal state. The use of bioenergy techniques can lead to an early diagnosis and follow up therapeutic intervention can stop the disease from advancing to a more serious state. Disease can be predicted before symptoms appear.

Bioenergy pictures can represent exact differentiated information. Clinically-manifested disease is topographically depicted on organ sectors in bioenergy pictures and this information concerns the developmental state of the disease. Presumably, more benefits await individuals who regulate their diseases when those diseases are at the asymptomatic state.

With these concepts in mind, one can find the energy loss with magnetic methods and one can also replace the energy loss and balance the loss through the same techniques.

How does the balancing of energy heal?

How does the balance of energy levels cause organs to heal? First, let me explain it in physiological terms and by explaining the concepts of depolarization and repolarization.

The nucleus of a cell is electropositive and spins in a clockwise direction while the outer shell is electronegative and spins in a counterclockwise direction, creating small energy fields like a tiny battery.

The cells also have a built-in chemical action to control energy balance. This is known as depolarization and repolarization via a sodium/potassium pump. Cells have a polarity with a positive charge (sodium) on the outside of the cells, and a negative or minus charge (potassium) on the inside of the cell membrane.

A healthy cell membrane will separate sodium from potassium, thereby creating a stable condition, but body cells receive constant stimulation which causes a constant change of the polarity. The positive and negative charges of the cells continually reverse themselves.³⁶

For example, potassium inside the cell goes outside as the sodium goes in. This is a normal biochemical process which requires the healthy membrane to act as sodium pump. The sodium pump allows this process to occur. This process is also one of depolarization and repolarization.

Since severe illnesses are the result of the accumulation of milder illnesses and a buildup of chemical toxins, the cure will come from detoxification and energy replacement therapy. Essentially, the different layers of illnesses and diseases are destroyed and the body is returned to health. When organs are on their way to recovery, they will undergo a process called retracting wherein they will experience to a lesser degree the symptoms which lead to the condition. The individual may feel worse at the beginning of the treatment until such time as the cells become detoxified. When the cells become detoxified, then energy can be restored quite easily through biomagnetic means.

Energy Flows in the Body and Causes of Interferences

In order to understand energy therapy, there are several concepts one needs to understand. First is that when the body is working properly, the organs function well within each system. The necessary hormones and enzymes are produced in proper amounts. The result is that the body emits a natural form of energy which reflects a healthy and well-balanced condition. The body's energy is used in work, in play and in maintaining an active life.

The body also needs periods of rest to establish normal cycles of rest and activity necessary for good health. Energy is produced by the metabolism of vitamins, minerals, and food, which are in turn transformed into enzymes. These enzymes help break down ingested food.

Another concept in physiology involves electrically-charged cells. Any cell in a healthy body should have an electrical charge of about 80 to 90 millivolts. Research shows that this energy flows through the body in a longitudinal route. The magnetohydrodynamic principle calls for energy to flow from the head down to the feet in the anterior part of the body, secondary to the influence of the flow of blood through the large arteries. Likewise, energy flows from the feet to the head in the posterior part of the body, secondary to the influence of the flow of blood through the large veins.³⁷

This is the basis of Chinese medicine, which has for over 2000 years been speaking about the flow of energy in the channels of the body. In the diagnosis of diseases, it is necessary to find out which organs are in a condition of excess energy, lack of energy, and blockage of energy.

Treatment consists of using the needle for circulating the energy through specific channels, thereby weakening or removing the block of energy in the diseased organ or the diseased channel.

Poor health can result from an imbalance of normal energy flows. A field of interference or a blockage of energy in an area can cause imbalances in body energy production and flow. Here are some examples of health-related problems that can "cause energy interferences:

- Any scar tissue resulting from a laceration or cut in the skin.
- Poor teeth, cavities, and root canals.
- Deficiencies in the body caused by poor diet and eating habits,
- Medications given to relieve symptoms of illness that simultaneously toxify an already sick organ.³⁸
- Quality of thoughts.

The body is a unified whole system which cannot be separated into parts. Health should be recognized as a totality. One can even consider the body as a "battery" or an electromagnetic field that can be affected by a leakage of a state of balance that disease cannot exist. When we find this type of person, we have always found that his body tissue is on the acid-side of normal and his blood is on the alkaline-side of normal. This is most often found in youth and slightly hyperthyroid people. As one grows older, the shift is for the tissue to go alkaline and the blood to go more acid. For this reason, as we grow older, we become more disease prone. We get sick more often and develop degenerate disease patterns and it continually gets harder to bring the patient back to a normal state of health.

Young people, on the other hand, are much easier to bring back to good health because of the ideal condition of their bodies' energy (acidic tissue-alkaline blood). It takes a much shorter time for a youth person to heal because of his ideal energy fields.

Dr. Samuel Schwartz, M.D., in presenting his work, "THE INCIDENCE OF CANCER IN PATIENTS WITH THYROID DYSFUNCTION" states "hyperthyroid people do not get cancer. If you transplant a cancer in a hyperthyroid person; his body will reject it. You must be hypothyroid before you can develop a cancer. All hypothyroid people, if left in that state untreated, will eventually develop some form of cancer, it may take 20 years, but surely they will get cancer."³⁹

If the hyperthyroid person becomes thyrotoxic, then he too can develop cancer and manifest other illnesses just as the hypothyroid person does.

Magnetic research shows us that cancer always seems to appear in areas or organs that are hypoactive or alkaline (for their normal state). Alkaline people have a low immune system so are unable to fight pathogenic cells. Hyperthyroid people have an active immune system and have disease immune tissue, thus are better able to fight cancer as well as almost every disease or pathology that presents itself.

It is our belief that cancer cells start out as normal symbiotic microbes with negative polarity, the same as the antibodies that fight disease. In alkaline tissue, they become toxic, reverse polarity, become electropositive and end up as a disease or cancer cell. This, in turn, creates irritation resulting in increased hydrogen, creating an acid medium which in turn causes the cell to reproduce more rapidly, thus promoting faster growth of the pathogenic cells.

In order to correct the condition, the body must go through a period of retracing, which is to go back to the condition that the body was in before the problem started. This reverses the energy field back to an alkaline state, thus slowing down the growth of the cells or pathogens. This results in the body's immune system being able to fight the pathology and brings about a healthy state to both body and tissue.

Hyperthyroidism is a manifestation of energy loss, as disease does, primarily developing from:

1. Poor diet and nutrition and/or poor environment resulting in toxemia of all kinds,
2. Lack of exercise due to our sedentary life style,
3. Stress.

This usually starts the process leading to energy imbalance and disease.

Since all electroenergy is produced only in the presence of magnetic fields, then man is a biomagnetic force. All of his organs and tissues are electric, thus his biomagnetic fields that create the energy necessary for life also control and balance the tissue and organs necessary for health.

On this basis, we can now understand that disease-causing bacteria and viruses are the result of changes in the condition of the body's energy fields from their normal symbiotic condition to a disease entity when conditions are ideal for the problem to develop. The bacteria and viruses are the result of the condition of the body, not the cause of the body's condition. Disease cannot manifest itself when the body's energy is balanced.⁴⁰

Dr. Vincent, in an article he published in France, states the B-Coli, with a normal pH of 7.1 in a healthy state, can be made more alkaline by decreasing hydrogen. When it reaches 7.3 pH, it produces bubonic plague, and when it reaches a pH of 7.5 it can cause typhus. Bring it back to a pH of 7.1 and it will again function as B-Coli.⁴¹

Virginia Wheeler, M.D., a cancer researcher, was looking for a cancer virus. She found a **photogenic capticide** which under normal conditions produces chorionic gonadotrophin, a substance necessary for life. When it becomes alkaline, it produces various forms of cancer. The earliest form was scleroderma, a form of skin cancer.

These findings support the theory that the disease-forming bacteria and viruses start out as normal symbiotic organisms necessary for life and when they found an ideal medium (abnormal tissue) for them to degenerate, they turn into a disease-causing bacteria or virus. Thus the disease-causing bacteria and viruses are really the result of the diseased body, not the cause.

In acupuncture, the theory is the same. The meridians are out of balance because the person is sick. Balancing them brings about temporary relief. Then they again become imbalanced and the therapist must keep balancing the meridians until the patient is better.

The total biomagnetic force of each organ causes it to react to conditions from within and without, compensating and adjusting to man's abuse and man interference.

To maintain physical well-being, the hydrogen ion must shift to utilize the energy for the maintenance of health. The shift of hydrogen increases the activity of some organs and decreases the activities of others thus setting up conditions in the body that make it ideal for diseases to manifest. Measuring the electric potential of the organs and systems and knowing what is happening makes disease predictable.⁴²

The disease-immune body has 100 percent total reserve energy available to all organs and systems. In an injury, sickness, or disease, the illness draws on the total reserve energy and if it takes more than 35 percent of this reserve energy to maintain life, then the person is terminal.

Our reserve energy always goes to the site of disease or injury to aid the body correct the condition and return it to normal. If we can return this energy in such a way as to balance it in the systems of the body, disease cannot exist and the body will go back to normal.

This is what polar therapy is all about - measuring the energy fields and balancing them. We do not diagnose disease or treat disease; we only measure the energy in the body's systems and organs and put them back into their normal state.

Each disease has a specific energy pattern and finding the energy pattern tells the therapist that condition in the client or the direction the client can go if the imbalance energy pattern is allowed to continue. This information could be valuable to any person, or doctor, helping them know what conditions could develop if attention is not paid to the stress that the body is under. Knowing the energy patterns, the doctor or therapist would know if and what tests are necessary, and how to treat them.

It can also tell the therapist what medicine is beneficial and the effects it can have on the body. It can also show the side effects of medicine and how to counteract them. The therapist can also tell how much will be beneficial and what would be too much. Nutrients will help balance the energy in the organs and systems, i.e. how much is ideal and when too much is causing the condition to return. The information is endless and its value cannot be measured in dollars and cents.

Magnetic Energies against Sickness and Pain

This material was found in an older issue of "Northern Neighbor", explaining the research being done in Russia as of that time (October, 1975). This research has been an ongoing program for many years with particular stress on the fact that each pole of a magnetic field causes different reactions to the hydrogen ion. These magnetic fields can be used to control the hydrogen ion. The magnetic North pole decreases hydrogen ion concentration while the magnetic South Pole increases hydrogen ion concentration.

This research explains why the results of the Russian research seemed such a mystery. Today we can scientifically explain what is happening and why, making biomagnetic science the science of the future. Within the next decade all healing will involve biomagnetic medicine.

Back in the 60's Soviet scientists began research in the new field of Magneto-Biology. The report, "Magnetic Treatments" was the first in the world on this fascinating topic (still the only authoritative account).

Recently, big advances have come in the USSR and other socialist countries. Over 2000 scientific reports have appeared, "Northern Neighbor" is glad to bring you the latest world from the USSR medical research centers.⁴³

The plain truth is that although doctors over here totally ignore Magneto-Biology, the effective treatment of many illnesses is being carried out today in many Socialist clinics, and most of the methods used are very simple, quite safe.

Magnetic "healing" was used in ancient times, especially for inner pains, cramps in the limbs, ulcers, and bleeding. In the last century, Russian doctors (notably the great Botkin) and French (Charcot) used magnets. Just before World War II Soviet research in Perm (Dr. B.I. Karmilov) noted good results with difficult skin. Magneto-Biology became a real science in the USSR, and then progress was rapid.

At first, magnets were used to hasten wound healing (after operations) and to improve blood circulation in people stricken by a serious blood vessel disease of the legs. Other doctors discovered marked beneficial effects of magnetic "fields" on bones and joints. This was so striking that careful studies were set up on animals. Very strong magnetic fields had bad effects on the bone tissue, medium and low strengths proved very beneficial. Healing of injured tissues sped up and superior bone growth followed. Long tests with continuous magnetic fields showed no harm to any organs or body tissues or functions.⁴⁴

Real excitement followed a near-tragic case: a noted Soviet surgeon was badly injured in an accident, and "open" fractures of his legs refused to heal. His colleagues were studying Magneto-Biology and he agreed to try "magnetic treatment". It worked dramatically; his bones healed. Many other patients verified these effects; magnetic fields markedly reduce swelling after fractures, improve the "blood picture", and hasten formation of strong new bone.

Soon experiments proved that a new, simple form of magnet, a flexible rubber strip coated with modern metal powder magnets, could be used to "bandage" many body areas. This is easy to apply, requires no equipment, and provides a steady medium-strength magnetic field close to the skin.

Specialists in Kiev and other centers then tried this treatment method on difficult bone, muscle, and nerve ailments such as bursitis. In many cases they observed marked decrease in pain followed by improvement or real cures. Soviet doctors stressed at "Northern Neighbor" that magnets are no cure-alls, but the scope of treatment has greatly widened lately, with the discovery that magnetic fields can favorably affect the central and peripheral nervous systems involved in pain and many ailments, especially "chronic" ills. Clinics in Czechoslovakia and Romania now widely use magnetic treatments, especially on difficult skin diseases.

You see the situation in the Soviet Union from this fact: they have started serial production of "Pole-One" to meet the demands of treatment clinics in many branches of medicine, and such treatments are officially recommended by the USSR's Ministry of Health. The newest discovery of Soviet doctors, biologists, and pharmacy researchers is "Magneto-Pharmacology-the science of using magnetic fields to improve the action of drugs and to decrease harmful side effects.

Today, specialists in all countries study the many things which influence drugs used on human beings—the time of day, weather, patient's mood, meals, liquids, etc. Magnets also change the effect of many drugs especially widely-used drugs for ailments of the heart and nerves. Such drugs, such as sleeping pills, used along with medium-strength magnetic fields, give deeper sleep, shorter, but far more restful, and a quicker waking. These effects are found in many patients, but not all.

Drugs given for "allergies" can be favorably affected by magnetic fields, and their side effects lessened. Many drugs cause an "allergic reaction" (sensitivity) in some people which can be lessened with magnetic fields.

This is no quackery. Today biochemists are keenly aware of the scientific fact that all molecules are influenced profoundly by magnetic forces, internal and external. Hence, the use of such forces to change the biological action of complex drug molecules is scientifically rational.

Magnetism: The Universal Energy

God and nature have given man and earth this magnetic force from the beginning of time. The earth's magnetism and what man has researched and devised, affects every living system on the face of this earth, the space above the earth, and the earth to its very core.

We are now learning that this energy affects all biological systems, even microorganisms from the first day of a human's existence.
